We feel very blest to be part of such a caring church family.





Dear Fareham Methodist Church members and leaders

I greet you in the wonderful name of our Lord Jesus Christ in whom we live and move and have our being.

As announced during the last few Circuit meetings, Rev David Muskett will be on sabbatical starting May until July 2023. I will be standing in during his absence and assure you of my dedication. With God's guidance I undertake to fill this role to the best of my ability as and when required.

Today I appeal for your help to add more people to our dedicated Circuit Steward

Team. At the start of our new Church year in September 2023, we will have only 3

Circuit Stewards with all the responsibilities of this role in Circuit on their shoulders.

The role of circuit stewards is an important one in the life of the Methodist Church.

Together, the circuit stewards dedicate their time to the more practical aspects of property and finances in the Circuit and provide a pastoral ministry to the ministers and their families. In a nutshell, they share the collective responsibilities and oversight for the spiritual and material well-being of the Circuit.

The role of a circuit steward can be demanding but is even more so when the team does not include enough people to spread those responsibilities among a larger group. A larger group of people also provides a wider skill set which strengthens the collective ability to contribute to the development of the work of God in the circuit. We need more people.

Trusting that God always provides and calls, I hope that you will open your heart to this call for Circuit Stewards and offer your God-given gifts and skills to serve in this role. Discipleship is at the root of all the work we do within the Church, and every role carries responsibilities but is also rewarding and stimulating in our journey of faith and service to God. East Solent and Downs Circuit needs you if God is prompting you to this vocation. God might also be prompting you with the name of the person who is called to this vocation. Will you then please share that with them or share their name with us?

It remains an honour to be part of a faithful and dedicated team of leaders consisting of laity, Deacons, and Presbyters - may God continue to guide and bless us all as we are witnesses of His love and mercy here where He placed us according to His plan and purpose.

You are welcome to contact me or any of the Circuit Stewards if you have questions around the Circuit Steward role and responsibilities. I add the role description for Circuit Stewards at the bottom of this letter.

Circuit Steward - Role Description

With the Superintendent and ministers appointed to the Circuit, the Circuit Stewards are responsible for the spiritual and material well-being of the Circuit and for upholding and acting upon the decisions of the Circuit Meeting.

Circuit Stewards:

- meet three times a year prior to the Circuit Meeting, as part of the Leadership team, to provide strategic direction for the Circuit.
- have a pastoral responsibility of care towards the ministers and their families.
- need to keep themselves informed of the activities of the local churches by being part of the Church Council for the churches to which they are allocated.
- need to be aware of the wider Methodist context and policies within which the Circuit operates.
- are responsible for bringing proposals for invitations or extensions to the

Circuit Invitation Committee and for conducting negotiations with presbyters as initiated by the District Chair.

- are collectively responsible for the Circuit funds, although in practice in the East Solent and Downs Circuit this is undertaken by the Circuit Treasurer.
- have responsibility for the maintenance of the manses within the Circuit.
- need to be alert to and take advice on the legal consequences of the office, particularly in relation to lay employment, finance and property.

The role is subject to interview and DBS clearance checks. In addition, there is a requirement to complete the foundation level safeguarding course.

Deadline for July efocus is 29th June.






