May Activities

String of Doves and Rainbows

You will need: Doves and rainbows to cut out (see template on page 5 of this document), scissors, colouring pencils or pens and very narrow ribbon.

Colour the 3 other rainbow shapes to match the



one already coloured in. Cut out the doves and the rainbows. If you would like more shapes you can draw round them on paper or card. Ask an adult to help you make a small hole in each piece and then thread the ribbon through them and hang it up.

The Dove is a symbol of Peace and the rainbow is a symbol of Hope for all our Worldwide family especially at this time of the pandemic.

Fruity and Veggie Folk (instead of a recipe this month)

You will need: a small plate; cocktail sticks; pieces of fruit and vegetables from around the world, such as carrot, banana, apple, orange, pineapple, melon etc Working on a plate, make a person by using cocktail sticks to join various bits of fruit and vegetable together.



Talk about the countries that the fruit and vegetables have come from. What can we find out about these places?

Make a Scroll

You will need: The letter printed on yellow paper (see template on page 7 of this document), 2 green sticks, 2 pieces of double-sided sticky tape and a piece of coloured ribbon.

Paul wrote to the Colossians encouraging them to keep living their lives in God's way. Some of his letter is printed on the sheet for you to make into a scroll.

- Stick double-sided sticky tape along the top and bottom edges on the **front** of the sheet.
- Attach the sticks to the double- sided tape; make sure they are stuck on.

Roll the top and bottom *inwards* till they meet in the middle.

Tie your scroll with the ribbon.
