

Jesus was very angry in the reading from the Bible that is set for today. It is from John's Gospel, Chapter 2 verses 13-16.

¹³ When it was almost time for the Jewish Passover, Jesus went up to Jerusalem. ¹⁴ In the temple courts he found people selling cattle, sheep and doves, and others sitting at tables exchanging money. ¹⁵ So he made a whip out of cords, and drove all from the temple courts, both sheep and cattle; he scattered the coins of the money changers and overturned their tables. ¹⁶ To those who sold doves he said, "Get these out of here! Stop turning my Father's house into a market!"

Jesus was angry because people were being cheated in a place which should have been used to honour God.
